No Surf House Announces Four-Part Concert Series Featuring National and Local Songwriters

Hudson, OH - No Surf House, a nonprofit organization dedicated to supporting the local music scene, is excited to announce the Saturday Songwriters Series at the Old Church on the Green in Hudson, Ohio. This monthly series will run from May through August 2024 and bring world-class songwriters to the former church built in 1860.

The all-ages series is presented as part of No Surf House's mission to increase the variety of live music available in Northeast Ohio and will bring nationally touring artists to a town that rarely gets to experience such original music so close to home. Additionally, the events will raise funds for No Surf House's other projects, such as the Home on the Road Program, which provides free or highly subsidized lodging at the nonprofit's Cleveland facility to touring musicians playing in the area.

"All three founding board members of No Surf Music are Hudson High School graduates," notes Executive Director Jason D. 'Diesel' Hamad, "so we're thrilled to be able to bring quality performances to our hometown. And we couldn't hope for a better location than the Old Church on the Green, a beautiful building with wonderful acoustics. These performances are not to be missed!"

Each show in the series will pair a nationally touring headliner with a talented local opener. The schedule for the series is as follows:

May 4th, Atlanta's Christopher Paul Stelling will be joined by Kent's Roger Hoover. June 15th Detroit's Jennifer Westwood and Stow's Kate Kooser will take the stage. July 20th, Nashville's Danni Nicholls will be preceded by Lakewood's Diana Chittester. August 3rd Nashville's Alice Wallace will be paired with Cleveland's G.S. Harper.
